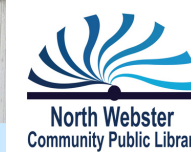

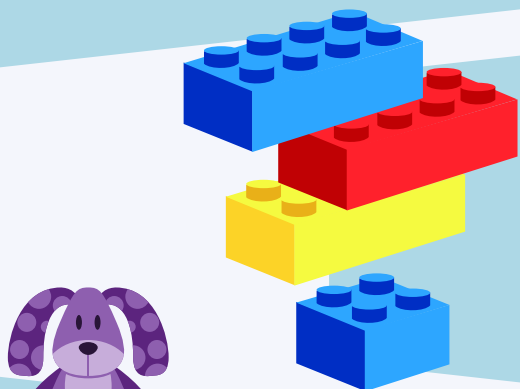

Are you struggling to learn the basics of your new tablet, phone or computer? Bring them to this informal tech tutoring session!

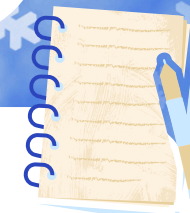


Adult Craft - Canvas Tote Bags Tuesday, January 14 | 2:00 pm
